BOOK CLUB - LORRAINE SAMIN


The story of a young boy, Richie, missing from a hotel room where he was left with three other boys whilst their parents dine downstairs. When his mother, Sara, checks on the children at midnight, he is missing. The boys swear they stayed in their room, and CCTV confirms Richie has not left the building. Despite a thorough

search, no trace of the child is found. Distrustful of the police, Sara turns to unlikeliest private investigators: disgraced cop Ted Conkaffey and convicted killer Amanda Pharrell. Their past personal grievances involving police corruption & wrongful accusations often play out in bizarre, humorous ways. Their investigations unfold a list of suspicious characters and mystery. The plot thickens as each of these is dismissed as being responsible. Red herrings are thrown around & nothing is guite as it seems. Ultimately, the truth of Richie's disappearance is uncovered and the outcome is unexpected. This well written, compulsive crime thriller with crazy characters and dark humour, underlines how people, personally & professionally, are unfairly treated when accused of a crime but subsequently found innocent. An interesting read!
